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Johns Bay Naturalist Trips Outline

Wildlife Paddle –

9:00 am OR 2:00 pm – Meet at Maine Kayak’s New Harbor Base

Morning to Noon OR Mid-Day to Afternoon – Pre trip briefing and go paddling

- Learn basic paddling strokes and proper boat form
- Leisurely paddle along Johns Bay shoreline – binoculars and wildlife chart provided - look for ospreys, eagles, terns, and seals

Sunset Paddle –

6:00 pm, 6:30 pm OR 7:00 pm – Meet at Maine Kayak’s New Harbor Base

Evening to Twilight – Pre-trip briefing and go paddling

- Learn basic paddling strokes and proper boat form
- Enjoy a magnificent sunset from the water and explore coves teaming with natural luminescence.
- Go paddling along the Johns Bay shoreline – discover Maine’s nocturnal sea creatures such as lobster.

Maine Kayak Ocean Adventure Upgrades Outline

Paddle and Puffin -

5:00 pm - Meet at Hardy Boat – Shaw’s Lobster Pound

Evening to Twilight – Puffin Cruise with Hardy Boats

- Enjoy a trip out to Eastern Egg Island to see one of the last remaining populations of Puffins.

Enjoy Dinner at Shaw’s Lobster Pound before or after your Puffin Cruise.

Paddle and Sail -

5:00 pm - Meet at Sail Muscongus (Friendship Sarah Mead) – Muscongus Harbor

Evening to Twilight – Sunset Cruise with Sail Muscongus

- Enjoy a sailing trip aboard the Sarah Mead to witness a spectacular sunset on Muscongus Harbor.

Enjoy Dinner at Shaw’s Lobster Pound before or after your Sunset Sail.

Directions to our Johns Bay Meeting Location

MAINE KAYAK'S NEW HARBOR BASE

Follow I-95 North (South-through Augusta) to I-295 until you reach Brunswick/Bath Exit 28. Merge onto US-1 North and drive through Wiscasset/Newcastle. Take the US-1-Business Route exit to Damariscotta. Turn slight right onto ME-129/ME-130 toward Bristol. Continue on ME-130 to New Harbor and make a right onto Huddle Road (follow the signs to Pemaquid Beach/Colonial Pemaquid). Maine Kayak is approximately one half mile on the right – just after the Purple Cactus Gift Shop. The phone number to the Maine Kayak office is (866) 624-6352. Please call if you have any questions.

Directions to Shaw's Lobster Pound/Hardy Boat

Follow directions to Maine Kayak but continue on ME-130 to New Harbor (do not turn onto Huddle Rd.) and make a left onto Route 32. Hardy Boat passengers must park in the ballfield. Continue walking on Route 32 North approximately 500 feet to Shaw's Lobster Pound. Hardy Boat tours meet at 5:00 pm.

Directions to Sail Muscongus/Muscongus Harbor

Follow directions above to ME-130. Continue on ME-130 to Bristol and make a left onto the Upper Round Pond Road. Continue to the stop sign and take a left onto Route 32. Continue north on Route 32 and take a right onto Muscongus Road. The Harbor is at the end of the road. Sail Muscongus trips meet at 5:00 pm.

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
